The Mary Hersey award is given for advancement in leadership roles and/or activism within the Union. Nominees for this award, women or men must meet examples of one or more of the criteria listed below and on the Nomination form.

- Minimum 2 years service with the Union.
- Service within the labor community.
- Served in a leadership role beneficial to labor.
- Served in a leadership role in coping with critical issues such as worker safety, minimum wage, comparable worth, human services, and/or political action needs.
- ❖ Participation in educational projects either through their local union or through some other labor organization.

NOTE: Women's Action Committee members and Council 2 Staff are not eligible for nominations/this award.
